FOOD Breakfast and lunch will be available at the concession, which apparently is so good that people stop off to eat even when they are not at a show. A list of restaurants for dinner will be provided. The nearby community of Midway is quaint and the eating is good. Also, because Frankfort is the capital of KY, and civil servants like to eat well, there are good choices in the area.

NAGGING There are two important reasons for getting your paperwork completed and in on time:

1. Gudmar has to guarantee a certain level of participation and takes the hit if we are wrong. It helps immensely to have some idea of the number of attendees to ensure that we get the attention we want from the show facility.
2. The show secretary and IceTest Wizard (IceTest is the user-Unfriendly FEIF software we are required to use to prepare judging sheets, results, etc etc) are volunteers. They work extremely hard at these shows. Their job will be MUCH easier if we are able to enter your information on a spreadsheet in the weeks and days before the show.

That is why we have reluctantly instituted a \$20 penalty for late / incomplete paperwork.
